

Reversi Board Game Instructions

2 players

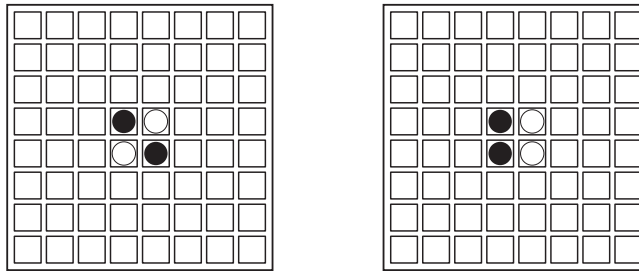
Set Up

Players mutually agree to play either **dark** or **light** colored pieces.

Light pieces play first. The board begins empty.

For the first 4 turns, players must play **within the 4 center squares** on the board.

Usually, the pieces are placed diagonally from each other.



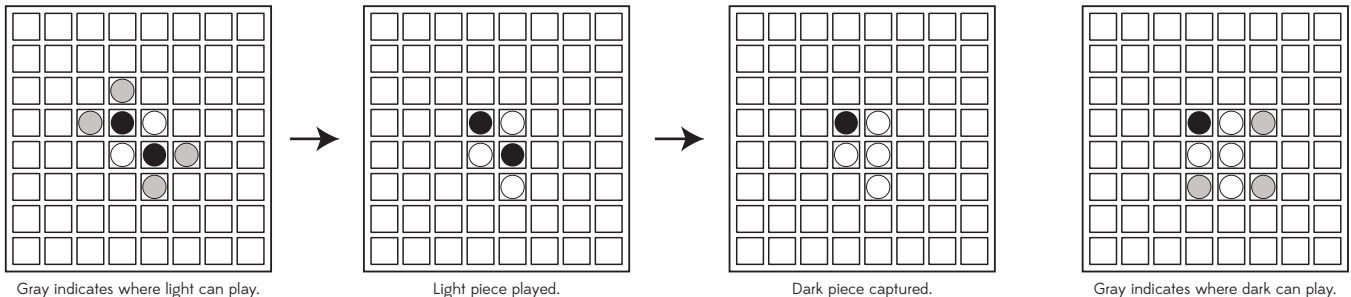
How to Play

Each turn, players place **one new piece** onto the board. The piece will remain in the chosen square for the remainder of the game - pieces cannot be moved.

Each piece placed must “capture”, or reverse, **at least one** opponent piece.

If a capture is not possible, the player’s turn is passed.

To make a “capture”, use your turn to place your piece adjacent in any direction to an opponent piece or line of opponent pieces, so that they are enclosed in a straight line with pieces of the active player’s color on either end. All pieces within that straight line (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal) are then reversed in their place to the active player’s piece color and “captured”. This ends the turn.



End of Game

Gameplay continues until the board is full and/or no pieces can be captured.

Winning Reversi

The player with the most pieces of their color on the board at the end is the winner.
